Both the petitioners are males and have attained the age of majority. They are stated to be in a relationship.

It has been averred that the relation between the petitioners is not acceptable to their family members and on account of which they fear for their life and liberty.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition and without commenting on the relationship/liaison between the petitioners, the instant writ petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent No.3 i.e. the SHO, Police Station Jamalpur, District Ludhiana confined to the aspect of danger that they apprehend to their life. In the eventuality of any such application being preferred, respectively No.3 would be obligated to examine the same and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
