The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 362 dated 27.09.2019, under Sections 323, 452, 148, 149 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the instant FIR is a counter blast to FIR No. 353 dated 23.09.2019 under Sections 376, 323, 342, 506 and 120-B IPC registered by the niece of the petitioners against the complainant and her relatives. He also contends that petitioner No. 1 is attributed a simple injury on the waist of the complainant while the injury, which is attributed to petitioner No. 2, is a fracture on the hand of the complainant but no medical evidence with regard to the fracture has been brought on record till date.

This Court, by orders dated 24.10.2019 and 28.11.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from Inspector Jai Bhagwan, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation and not required for custodial interrogation, the orders dated 24.10.2019 and 28.11.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
