The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.242 dated 25.07.2017, under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Focal Point, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he was found in possession of 24 bottles of country made liquor. He also contends that the petitioner had earlier been granted regular bail by the trial Court and had been appearing before the Court regularly except on one date, as he had wrongly noted the same. Consequently, his bail was cancelled. He undertakes that the petitioner shall henceforth appear before the Court on each and every date of hearing and would not absent himself except with the prior permission of the Court.

This Court, by the order dated 24.10.2019, had directed petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and in the event of his doing so, he was ordered to be released on ad interim bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been released on ad interim bail. He has furnished copy of the order of the trial Court dated 13.11.2019.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for petitioner, the order dated 24.10.2019 granting interim bail to petitioner is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.
