The petitioners filed Criminal Misc. No. M-13223 of 2019 praying for transfer of inquiry from ADGP, City-II, Amritsar Police, District Amritsar. The same was disposed of on 28.5.2019 with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to look into the representation dated 16.10.2017 which was with regard to the complaint against the private respondents (in the said Criminal Misc.).

Learned counsel for the State submits that inquiry is pending and it will take at least three months more to complete the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that she is not pressing the transfer of inquiry from ADGP, City-II, Amritsar Police, District Amritsar but the only grievance is that the inquiry should be

completed in a time-bound manner.

The contempt petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent to complete the said inquiry within 3 months from today and communicate the report to the petitioners.
