Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No0156, dated 25.09.2019, registered under Sections 15/29/61/85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur.

As per the allegations, 12 kg of poppy husk was recovered from the conscious possession of Amrik Singh, who had nominated the petitioner (his wife) as co-accused. The Court of Sessions has noted that there are 9 more cases against the petitioner, although, under the provisions of Indian Penal Code.

Hence, no ground to grant the concession of anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
