On 29.10.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner-Maninderjit Kaur prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.0031 dated 12.02.2019 registered under Sections 420 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station City-1 Sangrur, District Sangrur.

As per case of the prosecution, petitioner alongwith her husband had duped first informants of certain amount on the promise that accused No.1 would help them in immigration to Poland.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner got married with accused No.1 on 22.01.2018 and she has no role to play. It is further submitted that first informants had migrated to Armenia and since they could not adjust, therefore, present FIR has

been lodged.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Surinder Pal Singh Tinna, Additional A.G. Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.

Adjourned to 15.11.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Karamjit Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 29.10.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
