On 29.11.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in criminal case arising out from FIR No.138 dated 18.05.2018 registered under Sections 336, 323, 341, 427, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/27/54 of the Arms Act, at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the abovementioned FIR and there is unexplained delay of 3 days in registration of the FIR.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Hittan Nehra, Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on

behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.

Let a copy of the petition be handed over to learned counsel for the State during course of the day.

Adjourned to 16.12.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Amarjit Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 29.11.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
