On 20.07.2017, while disposing of the writ petition,
the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Grievance of the petitioner is that some unscrupulous elements have blocked the natural flow of rainy water leading to stagnation of water in the Tribune Colony, Nayagaon.

At the outset, Mr. Gupta, learned State counsel representing respondents No.1 to 3, submits that in case the colony is found to be an authorized colony, the Deputy Commissioner shall look into the matter and take appropriate steps.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further direction is necessary. It is made clear that, if required, the Deputy Commissioner shall be at liberty to seek assistance of officials of Municipal Council as well as the police authority.

Disposed of.

Report be filed in the registry with 03 months from today.”

The limited prayer is for channelizing the water
course.

As per the reply, a pump has been installed. However,
the respondent-Municipal Council is directed to ensure that the pump
installed remains in functional position.

Disposed of.

Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed
of.
