Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.118 dated 04.09.2018 registered under Sections 376, 511, 354-B, 34 of IPC and Section 18 of POCSO Act, 2012 at Police Station Ghagga, District Patiala.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the other co-accused, who has faced trial, has been acquitted by the trial Court. The petitioner has been declared PO in the case. At this stage, the counsel further states that now the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and therefore, he seeks withdrawal of present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, in case, the other co-accused has been acquitted by the trial Court after trial, and if the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court and moves an application for regular bail, the same would be decided expeditiously.
