The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.404 dated 25.08.2019, under Sections 186, 323, 353, 365, 379, 430 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Tosham, District Bhiwani.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the allegations against the petitioners are that they had assaulted a Canal Guard. He also contends that MLR of the injured did not reflect any injury as he was found to be complaining of pain. The petitioners are in custody for over 02 months and are not involved in any other case. He further contends that there is delay of 24 hours in registering the FIR.

Learned State counsel states that although challan has been prepared but the same is yet to be filed in the Court.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioners especially when the petitioners are in custody for over 02 months,

they are not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take sometime, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
