Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.174, dated 07.08.2019, registered under Sections 306/506/120-B IPC, at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

As per the case of the prosecution, husband of the petitioner had committed suicide leaving behind a suicide note wherein he has alleged that the petitioner had left behind a small girl, who has fallen from the bed and petitioner has gone abroad with 2 boys.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the offence under Section 306 IPC is not made out against the petitioner as the petitioner at that time was in Singapore, doing her job. In fact the deceased had dropped the petitioner at Amritsar International Airport on 02.08.2019.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, who is present in Court, has submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody after police remand of 2 days since 30.08.2019.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in

view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 30.08.2019 and the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
