On 29.10.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner-Amarjit Kaur prays for anticipatory bail in FIR No.156 dated 15.09.2019 registered under Sections 457/380/411 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is not named in the FIR and she is sought to be implicated on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused Resham Singh. He further submits that petitioner is a respectable resident of village being Member of Panchayat and she is sought to be falsely implicated.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Surinder Pal

Singh Tinna, Additional A.G. Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.

Adjourned to 15.11.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jagtar Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 29.10.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
