The present petition has been filed for for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 71 dated 27.06.2019 registered under Sections 22, 29, 61 of NDPS Act at Police Station Mohkampura, District Amritsar.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the name of the petitioner had surfaced during investigation. Still further, it has come out that there are four more cases against the petitioner, under the NDPS Act only.

Hence, this Court does not find any fault with the Order passed by the Court below while declining the anticipatory bail to the present petitioner. This Court also does not find any ground to extend the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is dismissed.
