It appears that on March 13, 2019, it was urged on behalf of appellant that there is a possibility of settlement in this matter, accordingly, the matter was adjourned to 03.04.2019. On 03.04.2019, both the sides submitted that the matter has been settled out of the Court. In such a situation, a direction was given to file an application under the relevant provisions of Civil Procedure Code, 1908, so that compromise can be considered by this Court and the appeal can be disposed of in terms thereof. On the next date, i.e., 28.05.2019, it was urged on behalf of both the parties that they want to file a joint petition of compromise under Order XXIII Rule 3 of CPC for disposal of appeal in terms of the settlement. On the next date, i.e., July 22, 2019, none appeared on behalf of the appellant and the matter was adjourned to 24.07.2019. A direction was given to the Registry to inform the counsel appearing for the parties regarding the said order. On July 24, 2019, none appeared for the appellant, however, in the interest of justice, the matter was again adjourned to 31.07.2019. It was clearly
