ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.0094 dated 16.08.2019, under Sections 365, 370 (4), 420, 120-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Division No.1, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein it is mentioned that two motorcyclists had kidnapped the son of the complainant. It is alleged that the petitioner had connived with the co-accused in the kidnapping of the child, who was stated to have been sold. He also contends that the child has been recovered unharmed and handed over to his parents. He further contends that the petitioner is in custody for over 3 months and not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel states that although challan has been filed but the charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when petitioner is in custody for over 3 months and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
