Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.202 dated 15.06.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 307 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Murthal, District Sonapat

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on the previous date of hearing i.e. 24.10.2019, passed the following order:-

“ Contends that initially petitioner was granted bail by learned trial Court, but subsequently offence under Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code has been added and police is trying to arrest the petitioner without taking permission from the concerned Court and thus the same is against the law laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court in judgment titled as Pradeep Ram Vs. State of Jharkhan and Anr 2019 AIR (SC) 3193.

Notice of motion for 06.12.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail

and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Contentends that in terms of the above order, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Sandeep, has acknowledged that in terms of order dated 24.10.2019, petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required. Also stated that there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner.

In view of above, interim order dated 24.10.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is also made clear that petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

Disposed off accordingly.
