The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.280 dated 22.06.2019 registered under Sections 279, 336, 120-B IPC and Section 13(1) of Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015 at Police Station Bilaspur, District Gurugram.

It is pointed out by learned State Counsel that the truck, from which 270 fresh cow skins were recovered, is owned by the petitioner. At the relevant time, the said truck was being driven by the co-accused Shan Mohammad, who was accompanied by his Assistant Sehzaad. Both of them have named the petitioner as the person who had got loaded the said consignment in the truck. Therefore, to unearth the true dimensions of the crime, the Police may be requiring the custody of the petitioner as well.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to exercise its extra-ordinary jurisdiction under Section 438 CR.P.C to release the petitioner on anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
