Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.247 dated 24.09.2019 under Sections 336, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 07.11.2019: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order dated 22.10.2019 passed in CRM-M-44953-2019, vide which co-accused Kanwaljit Singh @ Kanwal has been granted the concession of interim anticipatory bail. It is further submitted that case of the petitioner is on similar footings, as he was also not apprehended at the spot and there is no specific allegation against him except

that he was named in the FIR.

Learned State counsel has however submitted that the car, which was recovered at the spot, belongs to the petitioner and he may be directed to join the investigation.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Malkeet Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 07.11.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
