Pleadings on record have been perused.

The petitioners are both aged about 18 years. They seek protection of their lives and liberty from the family members of the first petitioner. The Aadhar cards filed by them in proof of their identity and age reflect that they are both residents of Gazipur in Uttar Pradesh. However, they claim to be presently residing with Arjun Kumar, the brother-in-law of the second petitioner, at New Colony, Near Municipal Committee, Mukerian, Punjab. Though no document is produced in proof of the residence of the said Arjun Kumar at Mukerian, Punjab, this Court is inclined to accept that he is the resident of the State of Punjab in as much as his Aadhar Card shows his address within the State of Punjab.

In that view of the matter, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2- the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, Punjab, that in case any representation is filed seeking protection of life and liberty, the contents thereof be duly verified and if

necessary, requisite steps be taken strictly in accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty to the petitioners.
