HARI PAL VERMA, J.(Oral)

Petitioner has filed the present revision petition against the order dated 06.06.2013 passed by Family Court, Ambala, whereby on a petition filed by the respondents under Section 125 Cr.P.C., learned Family Court has granted maintenance @ ₹10,000/- per month to the respondents from the date of order/passing judgment.

Vide order dated 05.02.2019, the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, the parties had appeared before the Mediation Centre and a report dated 03.04.2019 was received from the Mediator stating therein that the parties have settled their disputes amicably.

The Settlement/Compromise dated 01.04.2019 is made part of the record.

Relevant paragraph 5 of the Settlement/Compromise dated 01.04.2019, reads as under:-

“(i) The first party/husband-Narinder has agreed to pay an amount of Rs.45 Lac (Rupees Forty Five Lac only) as full and final settlement including all claims past, present and future as permanent alimony for maintenance of second party/wife which includes the interest of both respondents mother and daughter and mode of payment of Rs.45 Lac is agreed between the parties as under:-

(a) First party paid an amount of Rs.1 Lac vide demand draft No.142921 dated 30.03.2019 in favour of respondent No.1 today i.e. on 01.04.2019.

(b) An amount of Rs.4 Lac will be paid by first party to the second party on or before 18.04.2019 by way of demand draft payable at Bank of Baroda, Saha.

(c) An amount of Rs.20 Lac will be paid on or before 30.06.2019 and out of abovesaid amount of Rs.20 Lac, an amount of Rs.15 Lac, an amount of Rs.15 Lac will be deposited in the accout of respondent No.2 minor child by way of FDR and rest of the amount of Rs.5 Lac will be paid to respondent No.1 Sushma by way of Bank draft/RTGS.

(d) Remaining amount of Rs.20 Lac will be paid by first party Narender to the second party-Sushma respondent No.1 on or before 30.09.2019 by way of bank draft/RTGS.”

In view of the settlement/compromise so arrived at between the parties, the present revision petition is hereby disposed of.

The parties shall adhere to the terms & conditions of the Settlement/Compromise dated 01.04.2019 in letter and spirit.

The parties would be at liberty to have recourse to the contempt proceedings in the event of violation of the terms & conditions of Settlement/Compromise dated 01.04.2019.

Since the matter has been compromised between the parties

before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, no further orders are required to be passed in the application CRM-33219-2014 seeking condonation of delay in filing the present revision petition.
