The petitioners have filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the official respondents to take action and investigate the representation dated 14.10.2019 (Annexure P-1) made by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that Navpreet Kaur daughter of the petitioners aged about 18 years is missing since 05.10.2019 and efforts have been made to trace her out, but is of no result.

He further states that the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 14.10.2019 to respondent No.2 Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar so as to ascertain the whereabouts of Navpreet Kaur, but no action thereon has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 and 2 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Saurav Khurana, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-1) to ascertain the whereabouts of Navpreet Kaur daughter of the petitioners.
