This appeal has arisen from the judgment and decree dated 03.03.2014 by which petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 13(1)(i-a) (i-b) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act') for dissolution of marriage with the appellant-wife was allowed.

The appeal was admitted on 23.02.2015. The application filed under Section 24 of the Act thereafter, was allowed on the same day when the appeal was admitted. During the pendency of the appeal, the parties have entered into a compromise to finally part ways subject to certain conditions which are mentioned in the order dated 12.10.2018. The respondent has already paid ₹15 Lacs by way of FDRs of ₹7Lacs & 8 Lacs. Remaining ₹10 Lacs is paid today by way of demand draft issued in the name of appellant-wife.

In view thereof, learned counsel for the appellant has prayed for
dismissal of this appeal as not pressed.

At this stage, learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that family of the appellant has filed a case No.CRM-M-57227 of 2018 for seeking quashing of the FIR No. 104, dated 24.12.2014 registered at Police Station Titram, District Kaithal, for the offence punishable under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341, 427, 506 and 120-B IPC, on the basis of compromise. The said petition is now listed for hearing on 20.03.2019. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent has assured the court that the respondent would co-operate in the said petition for the purpose of quashing the FIR as the entire amount of ₹25 Lacs has been paid by respondent-husband to the appellant.

In view of the aforesaid, the present appeal is hereby disposed of as not pressed.
