The petitions filed a writ petition claiming the relief of regularization on the post of Data Entry Operator relying upon *The Punjab Ad hoc, Contractual, Daily Wage, Temporary, Work Charged and Outsourced Employees' Welfare Act, 2016*.

While issuing notice of motion on 28.6.2017, interim direction was granted that in the meantime, no adverse orders shall be passed against the petitioner.

The present petition is filed pleading that petitioner proceeded on maternity leave and thereafter she was not allowed to join.

Learned counsel for respondents on instructions from Mr.Navdeep Gill, L.A., O/o Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training, submits that the petitioner has rejoined from 28.11.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has not contradicted the aforesaid statement.

In view of the statement made, the contempt petition is disposed of. However, in case there is any grievance surviving, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.
