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RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE: (Oral)

Heard learned counsel for the appellant on the question of admission of appeal. This appeal has been filed against the order dated 18.09.2019 passed in Civil Writ Petition No. 26526 of 2019 whereby the petition filed by the petitioner for seeking protection of life and liberty has been dismissed by the learned Single Judge.

On perusal of the impugned order it is apparent that the appellant is the adopted son of respondents No.4 and 5 and he alleges threat to his life and liberty from his parents. The learned Single Judge has dismissed the petition on the ground that no FIR has been registered or filed by the appellant before the police authorities.

We have heard learned counsel for the appellant and we have also examined the order passed by the learned Single Judge. We have also examined the record of the case and from a perusal thereof it does not appear that there is any threat to the life and liberty of the appellant as alleged. In the absence of any FIR before the police authorities or specific assertion or allegation in this regard, we do not find any illegality in the order passed by the learned Single Judge. The appeal being meritless is accordingly dismissed.
