By this common order, above titled three petitions on similar facts are being disposed of. For brevity, the facts are being extracted from CRM-M-42257-2014.

Both the parties are *ad-idem* that the instant petition and other two connected petitions be disposed of while setting aside the impugned order or any other order passed by any of the Revenue Authorities in relation to the proceedings under Section 145 Cr.P.C. initiated by the petitioner with direction to the Executive Magistrate-cum-DRO, Karnal, to decide the proceedings under Section 145 Cr.P.C. positively within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by affording effective opportunities of hearing to both the sides. Impugned order or any other order of Revenue Authorities, are set aside pertaining to the proceedings under Section 145 Cr.P.C. between the parties.

In the meantime, both the parties shall maintain status quo qua possession over the disputed plot.
