Having considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for the parties and on perusal of the mode of partition dated 26.04.2006 (Annexure R-5/1) passed by the Assistant Collector 2nd Grade, Faridabad, the order dated 22.06.2010 (Annexure P-5) being not in consonance with the mode of partition, impugned order dated 03.03.2014 (Annexure P-7) passed by the Financial Commissioner (Revenue), Haryana, cannot be said to be without any basis or not in consonance with the records, do not call for any interference.

There being no merit in the present writ petition, the same stands dismissed.
