CM is allowed. Legal representatives of deceased Subhash Chander Dang as mentioned in para No.4 of the application are impleaded as party for the purpose of prosecuting present Review application only.

There is no ground for review of the orders dated 8.9.2015 and 12.10.2015.

When the direction as given is read in conjunction with the orders of the writ Court then it is evident that observations made by this Court in the order under review were in continuation thereof i.e. the orders of the writ Court which warranted grant of payment of arrears of pay with simple interest. The petitioner was working as an Architect when enquiry and consequent dismissal order intervened which was set aside by the writ

Court resulting in the aforesaid directions of grant of pay with simple interest. It is not in dispute that the salary has been paid alongwith interest. Evidently it would relate to the post the petitioner was occupying at that time i.e. Architect. Subsequently, the petitioner made a representation resulting in grant of notional promotions. The petitioner states that he would be entitled to monetary benefits on that score as well.

If that be so then it would not constitute a ground for review of the order which was passed noticing the facts and the petitioner would have remedy against the order passed by the respondents granting notional promotions which he has liberty to avail of.

Dismissed.

All pending applications are also disposed of.
