Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail pending trial in criminal case arising from FIR No.182, dated 10.10.2017 registered under Sections 18/61 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act at Police Station Doraha, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana.

As per allegations of the prosecution, petitioner was found in conscious possession of 4 Kg of opium.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody for more than two years.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh, has submitted that the prosecution has already recorded evidence of 4 prosecution witnesses and out of remaining 7 witnesses, 4 witnesses have been given up.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, learned trial Court is requested to conclude the trial of the case within a period of 3 months.
