Prayer of the petitioner in this case is to quash the disciplinary proceedings initiated by the Disciplinary Committee of the Institute of Company Secretaries of India, New Delhi, against one Mast Ram Chechi, Company Secretary. Be it noted that the said Company Secretary is not a party to this writ petition but the petitioner claims that the disciplinary proceedings have been initiated in relation to the evidence that the said Company Secretary adduced on his behalf.

As the said Company Secretary is the only person who can be aggrieved by initiation of such disciplinary proceedings and he seems to have no grievance therewith and has not chosen to come before this Court, no adjudication on merits is warranted in this case at the behest of the petitioner, a third party to the disciplinary proceedings. The writ petition is accordingly dismissed on this short ground. However, this order shall not preclude the petitioner from taking any remedial measures in accordance with law if he wishes to support and assist his former Company Secretary, Mast Ram Chechi.
