The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for releasing the detainee from the illegal detention of respondent Nos. 3 and 4.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner that the alleged detainee is in prison and stand convicted in FIR No.9 dated 20.04.2012, under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, registered at SSOC (State Special Operation Cell) Amritsar, District Amritsar. The detainee is serving sentence for the last 7 years on his appeal i.e. CRA-D-962-DB-2018 is pending adjudication before this Court.

Considering the pleadings in the writ petition and the arguments of learned counsel, this Court does not find any reason to exercise the extra ordinary writ jurisdiction.

Petition is dismissed.
