The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for releasing the detainee from the illegal detention of respondent Nos. 3 and 4.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner that the alleged detainee is confined in prison as undertrial prisoner in case FIR No.194 dated 05.09.2017, under Section 379-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Considering the pleadings in the writ petition and the arguments of learned counsel, this Court does not find any reason to exercise the extraordinary writ jurisdiction.

Petition is dismissed.
