Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.83 dated 10.07.2019 under Sections 306, 506, 34 of IPC, Police Station Chhajali, District Sangrur.

The aforesaid FIR was registered at the behest of petitioner, whose married sister Kamlesh Rani has died. She was married with respondent No.4-Pritpal Singh on 27.11.2013. As per the averments made in the petition, soon after the marriage, respondent No.4 (her husband) and respondent No.5 (father-in-law) started harassing the sister of the petitioner for bringing less dowry. On 10.02.2015, she gave birth to a male child. The father-in-law had bad eye on his sister and on 06.04.2018, he tried to molest her. Unfortunately, her husband also supported his father. Thereafter, his sister came to the parental home and panchayat was conveyed. The matter was compromised and her father-in-law felt sorry and his sister went back to her in-laws house. Due to this grudge, respondents No.4 and 5 gave beatings to her and on 10.07.2019, she died.

Notice of motion only to respondents No.1 to 3 at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Saurav Khurana, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

The present petition is disposed of at this stage, with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, District Sangrur to have fair investigation in the case.
