Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.205 dated 28.09.2019, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 326, IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 30.10.2019, passed the following order:-

“ *Contends that this is a version and cross-version and reference is made to DDR No.44 dated 30.09.2019 (P-2). Also contends that Section 326 IPC has been added later on. Notice of motion for 05.12.2019.*

‘*In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.* ”

Contends that in terms of the above order, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from A.S.I. Ajmer Lal, has acknowledged that in terms of order dated 30.10.2019, petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required. Also stated that there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner.

In view of above, interim order dated 30.10.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is also made clear that petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

Disposed off accordingly.
