Petitioner, who is the President of the Society, has approached this Court praying for issuance of a mandamus directing respondents No. 1 to 3 to take necessary action against respondents No. 4 to 9 which, according to him, are involved in acts granting unlawful promotion to respondent No. 7 to the post of Sewadar-cum-Chowkidar as well as Salesman on D.C. Rates.

What is apparent from the pleadings and the orders which have been passed and the complaint, is that the petitioner has a grievance against the earlier office bearers of the Society and has tried to make use of this Court as a tool to punish them which the Court would not become.

The writ petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
