The petitioner has approached this Court challenging order dated 24.9.2019, passed by learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division)/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rupnagar.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court does not find any ground to interfere with impugned order dated 24.9.2019 especially since the trial Court has infact permitted the petitioner to tender the documentary evidence regarding salary of his wife, which he had obtained by filing application under RTI Act. The order, as such, is upheld.

Needless to mention that the Trial Court while deciding the matter finally, shall look into all the evidence which is brought on record.

Since the learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that there still could be chances of amicable settlement, the Trial Court shall make another effort to probe the possibility of compromise and if required refer the parties to some Mediator.

The petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid direction.
