ARUN MONGA, J.(ORAL)

1. Petitioner herein seeks quashing of the order dated 09.10.2019 (Annexure P-8) to the extent of posting of the petitioner on reinstatement as Deputy Director, Bathinda instead of Amritsar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is blind to the extent of 75% as well as 50% orthopedically handicapped and requires special consideration on humanitarian grounds and yet disregard thereof, he has been posted at Bathinda instead of Amritsar.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner points out that there are six posts of Deputy Director, Department of Employment Generation and Training in the State of Punjab at Jalandhar, Ludhiana, Amritsar, Bathinda, Patiala and Chandigarh and submits that given the physical condition (disability), the petitioner is willing to be posted anywhere near to his native place i.e.

Pathankot.

4. Petitioner submitted a representation dated 27.09.2019 (Annexure P-11), but the same has not been adverted by the respondents till date. Hence, the writ petition.

5. Notice of motion.

6. On advance service of the petition, Mr. P.S.Bajwa, Additional A.G., Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the State.

7. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

8. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representation dated 27.09.2019 (Annexure P-11) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order sympathetically, in accordance with law.

9. Let the needful be done within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

10. Disposed of in above terms.
