Petitioner prays for bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.161 dated 26.11.2018 registered under Sections 21, 22, 29 of NDPS Act at Police Station Kot Ise Khan, District Moga.

As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner was found in conscious possession of 900 intoxicating tablets. Total weight thereof comes to 229.6 grams. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh has submitted that the petitioner is a habitual offender and he is involved in two more criminal cases arising from FIR No. 155 dated 13.11.2007 registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B IPC at Police Station Kot Ise Khan and FIR No. 50 dated 30.12.2016 registered under Sections 307, 353, 332, 323, 186, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib Panjtoor.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner in view of the

bar on grant of bail under Section 37 of the NDPS Act.

Dismissed.
