This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.153, dated 17.08.2018 under Sections 160, 283, 307, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Phagwara, District Kapurthala.

Perusal of the paper book shows that earlier the petitioner was granted interim protection by the Court below. However, the petitioner had chosen not to join the investigation or to appear before the Court. Hence, the application filed for seeking anticipatory bail was ultimately dismissed. The petitioner had moved an application for extension of the interim protection granted to him. Even that application was dismissed in February 2019. From February 2019, the petitioner has never appeared before the Trial Court or sought any other remedy.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to extend the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Dismissed.
