Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in case bearing FIR No.268 dated 12.10.2019, under Sections 458, 323, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 30.10.2019, passed the following order:-

“ Contends that both the injuries suffered by the complainant have been declared as simple in nature.

Notice of motion for 05.12.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of their arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit them to interim bail till the next date of hearing on their furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioners are also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Contends that in terms of the above order, petitioners have joined the investigation.

 Learned State Counsel, on instructions from H.C. Hardeep Singh, has acknowledged that in terms of order dated 30.10.2019, both the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required. Also stated that there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioners.

 In view of above, interim order dated 30.10.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

 It is also made clear that petitioners shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

 Disposed off accordingly.
