AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Resham Singh, who is present in Court to assist him, submits that the petitioners in these two petitions have joined investigation, pursuant to the orders dated 24.10.2019 passed (in CRM-M-46023 of 2019) and 01.11.2019 (in CRM-M-46526-2019), and presently their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, the interim orders dated 24.10.2019 (in CRM-M-46023 of 2019) and 01.11.2019 (in CRM-M-46526-2019), passed by this Court,

are made absolute, on the same terms and conditions.

However, this order will not be treated to be an observation of this court on the merits of the case, but only in view of the fact that the investigating agency itself has stated that it does not require custodial interrogation of the petitioners.

Naturally, the complainant would be at liberty to avail of his remedy as legally available, as regards any grievance, including the investigation process.

The petitions are disposed of accordingly.
