In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the counsel for the petitioner is that the pension of the petitioner @ ₹1500/- per month w.e.f. 01.10.2007 has already been approved vide order dated 10.09.2010 (Annexure P-2 colly) but the said order is not being implemented by the respondents without any valid justification and the petitioner is being still paid the monthly pension ranging from ₹250/- to ₹263/- per month without any valid justification.

Further, counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner underwent bye-pass surgery in June, 2016 and on the said medical treatment the petitioner had incurred a sum of ₹3,44,968/-, the bills of which have already been submitted by the petitioner to the competent authority but those medical bills have not been reimbursed to the petitioner without any valid justification.

The prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of an

appropriate direction to the respondents for implementing the order

dated 10.09.2010 and release the monthly pension of ₹1500/- per month w.e.f. 1.10.2007 along with arrears and interest and further for reimbursement of the medical bills amounting to ₹3,44,968/-.

Counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with the legal notices dated 04.07.2019 (Annexures P-1 and P-5), which are still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notices dated 04.07.2019 (Annexures P-1 and P-5) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notices dated 04.07.2019 (Annexures P-1 and P-5), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notices dated 04.07.2019 (Annexures P-1 and P-5) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notices, the same should also be paid to him within three months thereafter.
