The petitioner filed CWP No. 10238 of 2017 raising a grievance that in spite of serving for more than 26 years, no pensionary benefits were released to her.

The writ petition was allowed on 10.5.2019. The respondents were directed to treat the case of the petitioner under the Old Pension Scheme and while considering the case, the service rendered by the petitioner from 1984 till 2010 was to be treated as qualifying service for computing the pensionary benefits. The needful was to be done within two months from the receipt of certified copy of the order.

The present petition is filed pleading non-compliance of the judgment of this Court.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Mr. Inderpal Singh, Senior Assistant, Education Department, Punjab submits that claim of the petitioner under the Old Pension Scheme has been accepted and the amount shall be credited in her bank account within six weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has expired.

The contempt petition is disposed of at this stage. Let legal heirs of the petitioner complete the formalities with the respondents and on doing the needful, the amount be released within six weeks thereafter. The respondents shall also provide the details of the amount found due to the legal heirs of the petitioner.
