Through this petition, the petitioner has sought for a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents/State to grant the benefit of parole to the petitioner for a period of six weeks to attend the marriage of his nephew.

The petitioner was convicted and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 07 years under Sections 376/ 494/ 420/ 467/ 468/471/120-B/201 IPC in case FIR No.75 dated 25.02.2015 registered at Police Station Mahesh Nagar, Ambala.

Learned State counsel has filed the reply in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel points out that the petitioner has not even filed any application for parole before the Superintendent, District Jail except the oral request. He further submits that the petitioner has not completed 01 year of imprisonment after conviction as required for initiation of parole case.

No ground for parole is made out.

The petition stands dismissed.
