ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.12 dated 26.04.2019, under Sections 365, 323, 148 & 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Narot Jaimal Singh, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR was outcome of a misunderstanding between the parties. He also contends that the matter has been compromised. He has referred to the copy of the compromise (Annexure P-3).

This Court, by the order dated 30.10.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Manohar Lal, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 30.10.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
