The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC for expeditious decision of the petition filed by him titled as ***Parvinder Singh Versus Bandana*** Arora before the family Court-cum-Guardians Judge, Amritsar seeking custody of the minor daughter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though the petition seeking custody along with interim custody of the child was filed on 24.04.2019, but long dates are being given by the family Court in the case. Now, on the application filed by the petitioner for interim custody of the child, the case has been adjourned to 09.01.2020 for re-conciliation.

The order dated 05.10.2019 passed by learned family Court, which is attached with this petition, does reflect that the Court has already adjourned the case for 09.01.2020 for re-conciliation. Therefore, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the re-

conciliation could not mature on 09.01.2020, the family Court would make an endeavour to decide the application filed by the petitioner for interim custody of the child expeditiously.

The present petition is being disposed of without issuing notice to the respondent as it would not cause any prejudice to her. However, in case, she finds that any prejudice has been caused to her, she is at liberty to move an appropriate application.
