Pursuant to the order dated 06.11.2019, learned counsel for the State on instructions from the police official who is present in Court today to assist him, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

It is to be noticed that learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, has very fairly submitted that the petitioner has not deposited any amount as had been undertaken to be deposited on 06.11.2019.
