ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.42 dated 23.05.2019 under Sections 326, 323 IPC, registered at Police Station Ghuman, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner and the complainant are husband and wife and the petitioner is in custody since 19.09.2019. It is further submitted that there is a possibility of reconciliation between the parties, as the complainant has met the petitioner in jail in compliance of the order dated 20.11.2019.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhraj Singh and assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has, however, submitted that

one of the injury was declared as grievous. It is further submitted that though the complainant is ready to live with her husband/petitioner, however, she apprehends that she may again be harassed or humiliated.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without commenting anything on merits of the case and considering the fact that there is a possibility of some amicable settlement between the parties and reconciliation of the matrimonial relations between the petitioner and the complainant, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

It is made clear that after the petitioner is released on bail, thereafter within a period of 15 days, the petitioner will also furnish an undertaking of any of respectable member of his family that he will not misbehave with the complainant.

Liberty is also granted to the complainant to apply for cancellation of bail, in case the petitioner is found misusing the concession of bail.

Petition is disposed of.
