The letter sent by the petitioner-Bhupinderjeet Kaur to the office of Hon'ble the Chief Justice of this Court, was taken on judicial side and treated as criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

On 30.10.2019, cognizance was taken and report regarding the threat to the petitioner and her family members was sought.

In compliance thereof, affidavit of Amolak Singh, Inspector, SHO, Police Station Jandiala, Amritsar Rural, and affidavit of Manmeet Pal Singh, Sub Inspector, SHO, Police Station Ajnala, Amritsar Rural, have been filed in the Court today. The same are taken on record.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that the police officials had visited the premises of the petitioner in connection with FIR

No.245 dated 01.10.2019, registered at Police Station Jandiala, Amritsar

Rural. Neither Harmanbeer Singh, son of the petitioner was found at home nor he was taken away by the police. It is further stated that the petitioner's son has not been implicated in any case and is not wanted in any circumstances.

In view of the above, no further action is required in this criminal writ petition.
