The petitioner filed a writ petition seeking a direction to the respondents to promote him as Deputy Superintendent of Police with all consequential benefits. The writ petition was disposed of on 5.12.2018 directing the Director General of Police, Punjab to decide the legal notice dated 22.10.2016 and representation dated 30.10.2018, within six weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the judgment.

The present petition is filed pleading that needful has not been done.

Learned counsel for the State has produced order dated 14.12.2019, the same is taken on record and copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner. Vide said order, the claim of the petitioner has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the order passed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law to

challenge the said order.

Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
