By way of instant petition, the petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to provide him employment as per the Rehabilitation and Resettlement Scheme dated 18.11.1993 (Annexure P-1). The petitioner submitted representation dated 21.05.2018 (Annexure P-3) to the respondents but the same has not been decided till date.

2. In these circumstances, the petitioner also caused issuance of a Legal Notice dated 11.02.2019 (Annexure P-4) to the respondents, but the same has also not been adverted to till date. Hence the writ petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance service of copy of petition, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of respondent-State.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the legal notice dated 11.02.2019 (Annexure P-4) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

8. Disposed of in above terms.
